Within the last six months the above-captioned labor organizations have engaged in blocking of job site gates, acts of violence against employees and property, spat on persons and property, used offensive epithets against persons seeking access to the construction job site located at El Camino Community College, 16007 Crenshaw Blvd., Torrance, California.

The labor organizations' conduct violates formal settlement terms previously agreed to by the labor organizations in Cases 21-CB-14279 and 21-CC-3392, et al. Violation of formal settlement terms by the Regional Council and another of its constituent local unions is already a contempt issue before the NLRB's Contempt Division in Washington, D.C. in Cases 21-CB-14963, et al., and should be considered as yet another extension of the Carpenters' unlawful intimidation campaign throughout Southern California.

This outrageous misconduct breaches prior settlement commitments in Region 21 cases (Case 21-CB-14222, et al) and all available remedies, including contempt and injunctive relief, are requested.
