I was then choked and grabbed by a union official while engaging in protected union activities. This assault happened in front of the president of the IUOE Local 9 and another union official whom then perjured themselves to the local sheriff deputies. After this illegal action I was then denied a dispatch from these union officials until my employer threatened to hire me as a nonunion employee.
